

Fire Safety Regulations Outdoor Area(Part B)

- a) refer to the cover sheet: Behavior in Case of Fire

Fire prevention

- b) Prevent fires: fire, open flames (candles) and smoking are prohibited on the entire fairgrounds.

Escape and rescue routes

- c) Please note: Escape and rescue routes. Safety signs and lights must always be visible. Escape and rescue routes at stands must always be kept free. This also applies to stand parties at the end of the fair. Nothing may be stored below stairs.

Reporting and extinguishing equipment

- d) Use the SOS alarm unit on the light poles to establish voice connection to the emergency call center of the city of Munich.

Fire department (0) 112

Call the safety control office at +49 - 89 949-24555.

SOS alarm units are located on the light poles, which are equipped with a SOS sign in the upper part.

Obtain information about fire extinguishing equipment at the stand (fire extinguishers, fire blankets, etc.).

Memorize the locations of fire extinguishers at the stand. They are usually at the exits.

Fire extinguishers may not be blocked and must always be freely accessible.

Behavior in Case of Fire

- e) Keep calm!

Calm agitated people, and avoid panic.

Whoever notices a fire or a burning smell is to extinguish it immediately and warn those at risk if it is reasonable, in particular without substantial own risk and without violating other important duties.

If the person cannot put out the fire immediately, he/she must immediately alert the fire department.

Be careful when there are smoke-filled rooms! Do not inhale any smoke – danger of poisoning!

Wait until the fire department arrives, and follow their instructions.

Bring to a safe place

- f) If there is an alarm, the stand staff are obliged to accompany visitors from the danger zone and point out the escape route to them. At evacuation of a stand by stand staff, it must be ensured that there are no more people in offices, lounges, kitchen, storage rooms, etc. Please pay attention to the corresponding escape plans. All persons concerned must be brought to a safe place outside.

Try to extinguish the fire

- g) Saving people has priority over firefighting! Only try to extinguish fires without endangering yourself. Do not act alone.

Do not allow people with burning clothes to run away. Smother the flames; cover them with towels or blankets (work overalls). If necessary, lay the person on the ground and roll him back and forth. Do not leave fire victims alone (danger of shock).
